MUGA HIRING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All users are required to use the MUGA in a polite and sportsman-like manner. Prestbury Parish Council (PPC) expects that a good standard of behaviour will always be maintained. No bad language is to be used and noise levels should be kept to a minimum to avoid disturbance to our neighbours.

- 1. The letting is made on the basis that PPC accepts no responsibility for any injury, damage or loss incurred.
- 2. The user making the booking will be held responsible for the players and the supporters at any event.
- 3. For their own protection, the hirers are encouraged to have their own insurance and to carry a First Aid Kit.
- 4. Any damage to MUGA property must be reported to the Parish Clerk.
- 5. All teams must adhere fully to the start and end time of their booking.
- 6. The MUGA floodlights are operated by an automatic timer and will go out at 2100 hrs (9pm) prompt. Users are advised to nominate a timekeeper to warn players to vacate the pitch before the lights are extinguished.
- 7. To cancel a booking please contact the Parish Clerk. Cancellation terms and conditions apply your booking fee may not be refunded.
- 8. Correct and clean footwear must be worn. <u>Astro boots and trainers</u> are acceptable on the MUGA, but under NO circumstances are studs or <u>blades</u> to be worn as they may cause serious damage to the playing surface.
- 9. The MUGA is STRICTLY NON SMOKING. Smoking (including the use of vapes) is not permitted.
- 10. No dogs are allowed in the MUGA.
- 11. In the MUGA, no drinks, other than water are allowed, and no food items at all. Please ensure that any litter is disposed of correctly in the bins provided.
- 12. It is expected that customers are fully aware of the correct use of the hired facilities and equipment, and that they are used for their intended purpose.
- 13. All equipment must be put away by the end of the booking
- 14. Gates and fences must not be climbed over.
- 15. Any structures/banners cannot be installed without first obtaining approval from Prestbury Parish Council.
- 16. Prestbury Parish Council reserves the right to terminate bookings if the above conditions are not met.

All hirers must also read and abide by the PPC MUGA Hirers' responsibility document.

Where a user fails to follow the above rules, the PPC may decide to fine the user and/or cancel future bookings. All breakages must be paid for by the user responsible.
