



<b>44</b>	<b>Fly tipping on allotment site</b> – over the past few months fly tipping on the allotment car park has been a problem. The quality of the wood chippings has not be good and there have been branches, roots and rubble mixed in. In December the Chairman wrote to all tenants asking them not to give permission to anyone asking to put wood chippings on the allotment site but instead to refer that person to the Parish Clerk to seek permission. The Committee will monitor this problem and write to one company who has been identified. Tenants are asked to make a note of any vehicle seen illegally fly tipping on the site and report it to the parish Office so that action can be taken: need date, time, registration number and company name (if any). If the problem persists we have the option to close the gate which has a combination lock but this would rely on all tenants closing it after entering/exiting the site.	<b>PK</b>
<b>45</b>	<b>Infrastructure &amp; Maintenance:</b>	
<b>/1</b>	<b>Water</b> – letter from water company informing us that they were unable to read the water meter <i>“couldn't get access to the meter because it's buried underground.”</i> This is rather peculiar as meter has not been moved to our knowledge and is hopefully in the same place as it has always been e.g underground. ARs to verify existence of and read meter, PK to submit reading to water company.	<b>AR PK</b>
<b>/2</b>	<b>Tracks</b> – Six tonnes of Type 1 gravel, for filling the pot holes in the site tracks, was delivered in November. Some has been spread by ARs and tenants using wheelbarrows but require Groundsman to move some using the tractor bucket. Discussion about scalpings versus gravel: availability and requirement, ongoing.	<b>AR</b>
<b>/3</b>	<b>Asbestos</b> – the asbestos shed on Plot 11A has been removed. The shed was full of rubbish and had to be emptied, rubbish requires a skip to dispose of, PK to investigate cost. Discussion about how to prevent skip being filled with “unofficial” rubbish before we get a chance to fill it.	<b>PK</b>
<b>/4</b>	<b>Fence</b> – there is a requirement for fencing to fill a gap to the north of the car park. PK to liaise with Clerk and Groundsman.	<b>PK</b>

<b>/1</b>	<b>Produce Show 2023</b> – it was agreed that Committee would canvas support for a produce show later this year, there has not been a show for a few years for various reasons. PW and AR to report finding at next meeting.	<b>PW/AR</b>
<b>/2</b>	<b>Fireworks</b> – a complaint was received that fireworks had been launched from the allotment site on Christmas Eve. It was decided that the Terms & Conditions be updated to prohibit the use of fireworks by tenants.	<b>PK</b>
