**What:** Road closure for ground investigation works

**Where:** **B4632 Cheltenham Road Cleeve Hill** - see overleaf for details of road closure.

**When:** **20<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023, 24/7 closure**

We will shortly be undertaking ground investigation works at this location.

The carriageway on the B4632 road has been showing signs of deformation, requiring frequent repairs to make it safe for road users. It is understood that this deformation is caused by slow ground movements.

## ROAD CLOSURE

A ground investigation is required at the site to verify the material beneath the road, and also upslope and downslope. The planned works would see 7 boreholes drilled across the site to retrieve geological samples and install monitoring equipment. This information is important in case there are any future movements which could lead to reconstruction of the road. The road closure is needed to allow drilling rigs and crew to safely undertake this ground investigation.

We appreciate road closures are inconvenient, but in order to keep you and the team working on the road safe it is necessary. We have planned the work so we can be in and out as quickly as possible.

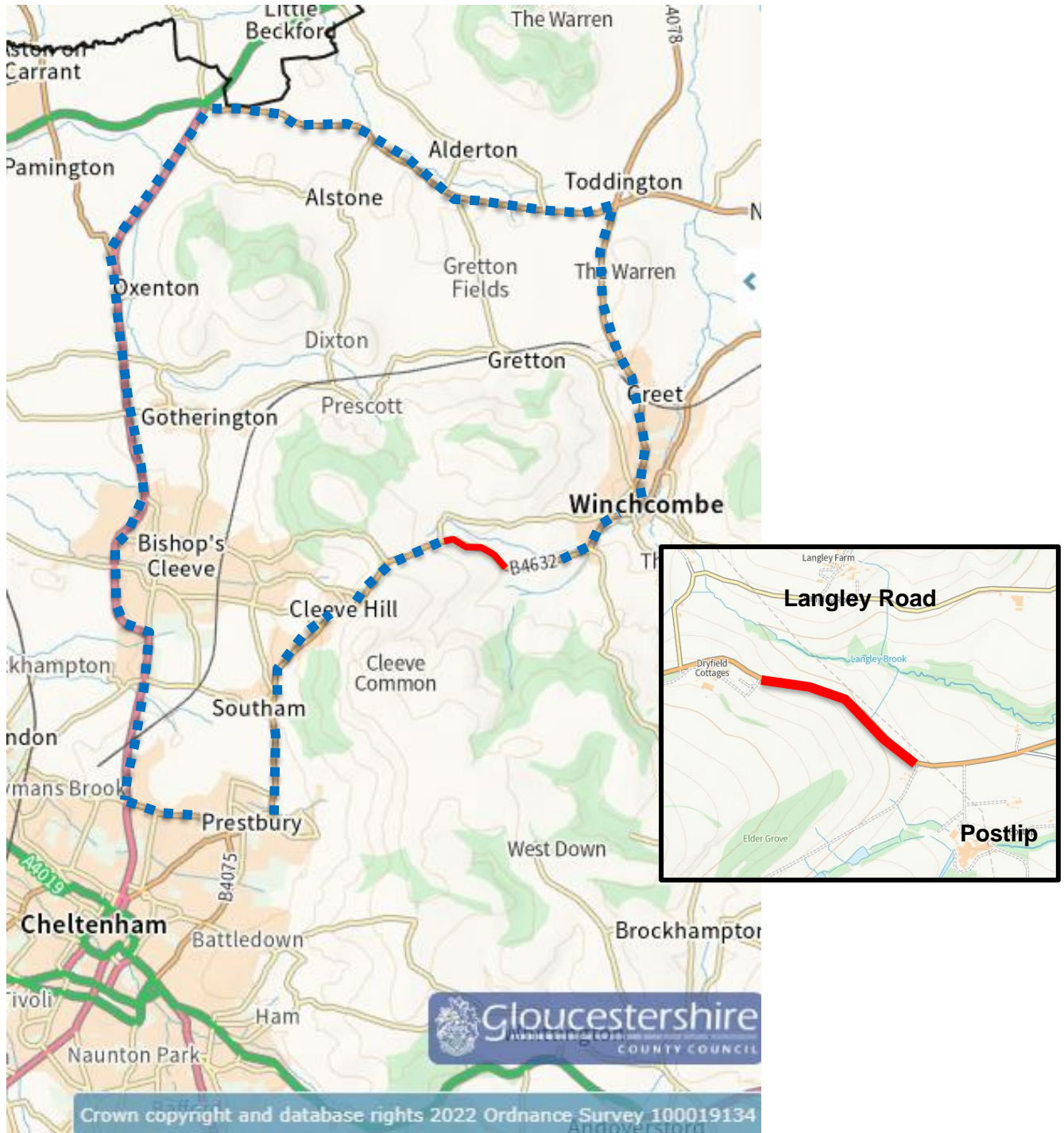
## Diversion

We have created an official diversion route which will be signposted and is suitable for all vehicles that would normally use the closed road. We appreciate you may know an alternative route, however, please be aware alternative routes which are outside of the road closure area are used at driver's discretion and may not be suitable for larger vehicles.
