

## EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE 490066 LINDEN AVENUE (PRESTBURY WARD) CHELTENHAM BOROUGH

Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority, has, by this emergency notice, closed temporarily, under the relevant provisions of Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of the 490066 Linden Avenue road, from its junction with Brymore Close, to its junction with Linden Close, for an approximate distance of 10 metres ("the Road")

The Road falls in the Prestbury Ward in Borough of Cheltenham, within the County of Gloucestershire.

The reason for the closure is for urgent Severn Trent Water mains repair works, following a water leak.

This Notice comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023 and may continue in force for up to 21 days. It is however anticipated that the works will be completed by 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023. If the works to remedy the problem have not been completed within the 21 days allowed for in this Notice, it will be necessary to either extend the closure by another Notice, for a further 21 days, or make a Temporary Road Closure Order. If necessary, this Order could authorise the closure of the Road for up to eighteen months from the date of this Notice.

Pedestrian access and emergency access will be maintained.
