Consideration should be given to priorities for cyclists v motor vehicles when exiting the property.</p> <p><u>Removal of hedgerow from A435 Cheltenham to Bishops Cleeve</u></p> <p>Street Record Evesham Road Cheltenham Gloucestershire Ref. No: 24/00125/HED</p> <p>Outcome: No objection</p> <p>Comment: Prestbury Parish Council supports this application on the understanding that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It would be very difficult from an engineering and safety perspective just to put the cycle path between the road and the existing hedge thereby leaving the existing footway on the west side and retaining the current hedge. 2. GCC intend replanting as many of the native species in the current hedge in a new hedge that will be bulked up with additional naive species. This will be sited further to the east to give enough space for a safe and well engineered cycle path and a pedestrian footway. 3. The 40 trees that will be removed will be replaced with many more than 40. 4. No work will be done during the nesting season from 1 March and biodiversity officers will be on site during the re-siting of the hedge. <p><i>Agreed</i></p>
